Invitation to review an Online Public Exhibition relating to the proposed new build accommodation at Stebbing Primary School, Dunmow.

Essex County Council, as the Education Authority, proposes to provide new build accommodation to replace the temporary accommodation at Stebbing Primary School. A new classroom will be provided along with associated storage, cloak-area, WC facilities and hygiene room. The project design team has been working with Stebbing Primary School to develop a proposal that would meet the school's educational need and fits well on the school site.

We would like to invite you to an online exhibition to review the current proposals and to have your say before the proposals are completed for submission to the County Planning Authority as a detailed planning application.
