



The home school agreement sets out the expectations of the school, parents and pupils.

The school will:

- Provide a safe, happy and stimulating environment.
- Support and encourage each child to develop a positive attitude to learning and do their best at times.
- Aim for each child to achieve their potential and be an independent and self-motivated learner.
- Provide a broad, balanced and creative curriculum.
- Inform parents of their child's progress through regular meetings with the class teacher.
- Provide a written report once a year.
- Alert parents to any difficulties or concerns the school has regarding their child's behaviour learning.
- Encourage every child to become increasingly more responsible.

The parents/carers will:

- Ensure their child attends school, arrives on time and is ready to learn.
- Ensure their child wears the correct uniform.
- Ensure their child has the correct clothing and equipment for the activities for that day.
- Ensure they do not take their child out of school for holidays during the school term.
- Attend parent's consultation meetings to discuss their child's progress.
- Support their child with homework and other opportunities for school learning.
- Encourage their child to have high standards of behaviour at all times and support the school following the school's Behaviour Policy.
- Support their child by attending at least one school-based parent workshop per year.
- Take an active and positive interest in their child's education.
- Support the AFSS and offer their services at least one event per year.
- Encourage their child to be more responsible and achieve their STEPs challenge.

The pupils will:

- Always try their best when doing classwork and complete homework.
- Keep to their class and Golden Rules:  
-Be kind-Be gentle-Work hard-Look after property-Listen-Be helpful.
- Take care of equipment, buildings and surroundings.
- Try their best to become more independent and responsible as they get older.
