GUEST SPOT - PHONICS SCREENING CHECK

The Phonics Screening Check is a quick, relaxed check-in that all Year 1 children in England do every June to confirm they have learned phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. Your child will sit one-to-one with their teacher for about 5 to 10 minutes to read a list of 40 words out loud. Half of the list is made up of real words, and the other half are silly "alien words" (complete with a picture of a friendly monster!). Nonsense words are an important part of the check as they cannot be guessed by memory, therefore the children have to use their sound-blending skills to work them out. This is a great way for us to see how their reading is coming along and spot if they need a little extra boost as they head into Year 2.
