





















A Story about a Stebbing Event: The Christmas Market

<p>Sometimes it can be difficult to make a quick decision on what to buy.</p>		<p>There can be only one of each gift, and so I may not be able to buy the same gift as someone else.</p>	
<p>I can buy a gift for myself if I have bought one gift for everyone on my list and I have enough money left.</p>		<p>When I have bought all my gifts I will take them back to a classroom.</p>	
<p>In the classroom I will wrap my gifts myself; there will be adults in the room who can help me.</p>		<p>I will take any left over money home.</p>	
<p>I will take my wrapped gifts home. I will give the gifts to my friends and family.</p>		<p>The people you give my gifts to will feel happy to open them on Christmas day.</p>
